Remarks from Councillor Darren Hill

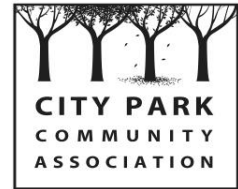
- curbside swap part of annual operating budget so should be ongoing
